

The FiberTrain Festival 2015 Fleece Show and Sale is open to ANY fiber producer to show and sell their fleece.

All Vendors at FiberTrain Festival are required to sell whole fleeces through the Fleece Sale. Sale of whole fleeces is not permitted within Vendor booths.

- There is **no fee** to enter a fleece for judging or sale. By entering your fleece in the sale, you are agreeing to donate 15% of the total sale price to cover judging and administrative costs if the fleece sells.
- Please complete all required information on the form. **To expedite the check in process, please bring a completed and signed Registration Form and one Fleece Card for each fleece entered.**
- **A completed Fleece Card must be presented at check-in with each fleece.** The card can be found on the FiberTrain Website under the **About Us** Tab.
- You may include business cards, personal information, etc. on the Seller Portion of the Fleece Card. No identifying information can appear on the Judges Portion to maintain the integrity of the judging process. FiberTrain staff will open up the fleece cards after judging, before the Fleece Sale starts.
- All fleeces must be raw (unwashed), well skirted, and free of foreign matter as much as possible. The staff will be checking to ensure that fleeces are healthy, untied, with out tags, bugs, second cuts or excessive debris. Buyers love clean wool and this is what we want to sell them so they will keep coming back to our Festival. Alpaca fleeces may be Blanket, Neck/2nds Only, or a combo if labeled accordingly.
- **Clear plastic bags (e.g. custodial-type garbage bags available at Costco) are a must. Please use a size that "fits" the fleece.**
- Fleece of any fiber animal are eligible to be judged or placed in the fleece sale.
- **All fleeces must be checked in at the Info Booth by 4pm on Sunday, May 24.** Fleeces will be inspected for quality and proper packaging and assigned an ID number. Winners will be announced at 8 a.m. on Monday. Ribbons may be collected at that time by the grower, or become property of the buyer.
- **The Fleece Sale will begin at 8:30 a.m., Monday, May 25** after the announcement of the Show winners. The sale will end at 5 p.m.
- Classes will be set by wool grade and/or species. Classes may be subdivided, combined or deleted at the discretion of the judge or Director. Colored and Crossbred fleeces are welcome!
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each class. Rosettes are awarded to the Grand Champion and Reserve Champion of the show.
- In order to allow for credit card payments and to avoid any issues with Idaho State sales tax, **buyers will make payments directly to FiberTrain Festival at the FTF Info Booth. Checks will be issued to producers for fleeces sold (minus 15% donation) no later than June 2, 2015 by mailing addresses provided on your registration forms.**
- Producers need to check-out at the Info Booth by 7 p.m. on Monday, May 25, 2015. **All producers MUST complete the check-out process to claim their unsold fleeces and confirm payment information.**
- Unclaimed fleeces will be considered a donation to FiberTrain Festival. FiberTrain and its staff/judges assume no responsibility for lost or damaged fleeces.

The FiberTrain Director has absolute authority over the above terms and conditions, and their decision on all matters and interpretation of any rules is final. The FiberTrain Staff/judges reserve the right to refuse/disqualify fleeces for any reason from being entered into the sale.
